

2020 Cape D'Or Cabernet Sauvignon

The fruit for this cabernet sauvignon was sourced from sustainable, dry land vineyards in South Africa. These vineyards are located in the Western Cape region of South Africa where cool afternoon breezes allow for favourable ripening conditions. Working with fruit from some of the oldest deposits of granite and shale soils on the planet allows for a balance between old world texture and new world freshness.

Tasting Notes

The 2020 Cape D' Or Cabernet Sauvignon is made with a minimal intervention wine making approach. The goal here is to allow the varietal to showcase its true characteristics. Aromas of dark fruit, subtle spices and hits of liquorice are met with a well-structured mouthfeel, showcasing a classical cabernet tannin structure.
